FROM FATHER'S DESK

Father Nathaniel Meyers



Archbishop Hebda's pastoral letter, *You Will Be My Witnesses*, was promulgated last November on the Feast of Christ the King. I have heard from a number of parishioners that they either have read or are currently reading the document, each of them relaying hope for the Archdiocese based on the renewed focus of evangelization that will be prioritized by the Synod implementation. Each parish is tasked with creating an Evangelization Team that will work with the pastor to develop and implement a plan of evangelization for the people of each parish, school, and other Catholic institutions throughout the Archdiocese. As the Evangelization Teams get to work in the upcoming months, they will all be undergoing training to equip them for this work.

Beginning Tuesday, February 7th, we will be hosting one of the training sites for the parishes of our deanery. The training will occur on seven consecutive Tuesdays in Parish Hall and not only draw people together for formation in evangelization, but also time for prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. I am honored that our parish was selected by the priests of our deanery and Archbishop Hebda to host this training, but it will obviously result in some changes to our regular schedule during those seven weeks. Due to the training, the groups that regularly meet in Parish Hall on Tuesday evening will no longer be able to do so and will either need to change their location or the time of their meeting. More significantly, however, this will also require us to slightly change the time of our Tuesday evening Mass from 6:30 p.m. to 6:15 p.m. to allow for the training sessions to begin at 7:00pm.

While it is never ideal to change the sacramental schedule as it can lead to much confusion, I see this as a great opportunity for us to make a slight adjustment that helps our parish be a part of the local church and realize our mission is not one lived in isolation, but rather with the whole Archdiocese and indeed the Catholic Church throughout the world and time. As we get ready to begin hosting the Evangelization Team training for our deanery, I ask everyone to pray for our parish's Evangelization Team members and also those men and women who will be taking part in this work for their respective parishes throughout the Archdiocese. Pray that each of us will be obedient to the Holy Spirit and work to live and witness to the deposit of faith we have all received.

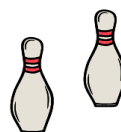
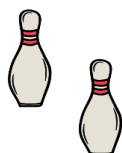

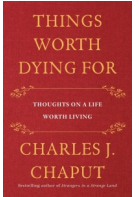

THINGS WORTH DYING FOR — BOOK STUDY

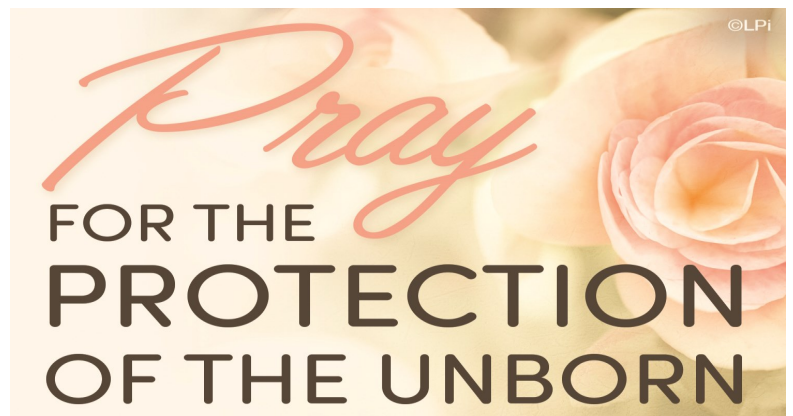
Sign-Up For A Small Group Today!

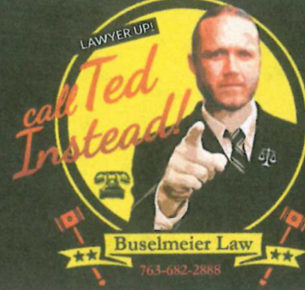
