

FROM FATHER'S DESK

Father Nathaniel Meyers



We celebrate Deacon Alex Rasset's entrance in Holy Orders this weekend, which is indeed a cause for rejoicing. Dcn. Rasset joins Sofia Nikula, who entered the Carmelite convent last year, as another young person from our parish making a truly profound commitment to Jesus Christ and His Church. Praises should indeed be directed to God not only for choosing Dcn. Rasset and Sofia for these lofty vocations, but also for His granting them the grace to cooperate with their respective calls. My sincere prayer is that other young men and women in our parish will follow their example and choose Holy Orders or religious life as I cannot imagine there are not more among our ranks that God desires to become priests, monks, or nuns.

As we rightly celebrate Dcn. Rasset's diaconal ordination this weekend and look forward in joy to his presbyteral ordination next year, one of the key aspects of this celebration should be the explicit encouragement of such vocations in our children and grandchildren. I have sometimes heard parents who suspect a son has a vocation to the priesthood say that they are purposefully not encouraging him to pursue it, lest the young man feel obligated to become a priest. Truthfully, I think such an approach is a mistake. While we certainly want young men and women to embrace priestly or religious vocations freely, why wouldn't we encourage them to pursue something that can do so much good and seems to fit them well? Children are often encouraged to pursue athletics that they like or where they demonstrate a noticeable talent. One imagines many parents with an artistically inclined child would help that child pursue a career that would incorporate such gifts. Indeed, it would be peculiar not to do so, yet there seems to be a hesitancy among even the most devoted Catholics to actively encourage priesthood or religious life for their children.

To all of our parents and grandparents, I ask you to not be afraid to directly encourage religious and priestly vocations. The discernment process will be there to help them along the way and God's Providence will reveal to them if they should pursue married life instead. However, if we do not carve out in a deliberate manner the room for young men and women to actively consider priestly or religious service, then God's call can easily be lost in a flood of noise arising from social media, peer pressure, consumerism, and a whole host of other influences arising from the world. Today we celebrate a new deacon from our parish, but may he not be the last.






