

## FROM FATHER'S DESK



Father Nathaniel Meyers

On behalf of our parish's leadership, I want to express my gratitude to all who have made our parking lot project a success. Thanks to the generous contributions of so many parishioners, including having a sizable church preservation fund that we were able to use to help with getting the project off the ground, we have been able to achieve the parking lot expansion and re-grading without incurring any additional debt. While the vast majority of our project is now completed, no doubt each of us is aware that some landscaping and additional items still remain.

The landscaping will be completed over the next few weeks so that we have everything set before the ground freezes and winter begins. We are planning to place rocks in the islands and to seed alongside the sidewalk as we get everything set for the winter. There will also be construction cleanup that occurs at the same time that the landscaping is set before winter. Depending on how things look in the spring after the snow and ice melt, we may do some additional planting and landscaping at that time as well.

The lighting for the parking lot should be completed within the next week as the poles for the parking lot arrived late this past week. While we had hoped for them to be done shortly after the completion of the lot, the supply chain hold-ups continue to have occasional issues in securing such materials. Thankfully, they will be installed before the shorter days really take hold and make it difficult to see following the evening Masses and the early morning hours. As these final projects are completed, please know that we are grateful for everyone's support in making this project another success here in our parish. God bless you all.






#### WEDNESDAY MORNING WOMEN'S GROUP



#### CATHOLIC Q & A: ANNULMENTS

Question: After a civil divorce, is a Catholic obligated to pursue an annulment?

Answer: Many Catholics are not exactly sure what an annulment does. An annulment does not deny that a marriage took place, nor does it deny that there once was love. It does not mean that people say anything untrue, such as they never loved each other or that everything in their marriage was wrong. An annulment does not negate children, nor make them illegitimate. An annulment addresses the spiritual aspect of marriage. In effect, an annulment says that at the time of the wedding, there was either something present or something absent that prevented the sacrament from taking place. It is a spiritual determination that, if granted in the affirmative, allows a person to marry in the Church.

Annulments have no legal standing and are unable to be used in a civil court. Therefore, a Catholic has no moral obligation to pursue an annulment. However. when the tragedy of divorce occurs, and there is no hope for reconciliation, annulments may help bring some spiritual closure to a person's life. Some people have found the process to be healing and others have found it to be difficult. Speak to your priest or a member of the Diocesan Tribunal staff to decide what is best for you.

















