FROM FATHER'S DESK

Father Nathaniel Meyers



At Mass last weekend, we announced that the Knights of Columbus in our parish are looking to have a bronze statue of their founder, Blessed Michael McGivney, placed in the alcove on the church's north side as people walk in from the parking lot. Pictures of the statue can be seen in the Gathering Space and the Knights have an anonymous donor who will match donations. The hope is that members of the parish will be able to contribute \$10,000 towards this project and the rest will be covered through the anonymous donor from the Knights. I encourage everyone who is able to contribute towards this to do so by placing their offering in the red envelopes at the end of the pews; checks can be written out to the Knights of Columbus.

Statuary is a common part of Catholic devotion and worship. Indeed, we already have statues of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Blessed Mother, St. Joseph, St. Thérèse of Lisieux, and St. Francis Xavier. One might rightly ask, why add an additional statue or why one of Bl. Michael McGivney in particular? There are several reasons for using statuary as part of the faith. The first is that as embodied beings, we have physical senses and our body is an intrinsic part of our life and, therefore, a part of our faith. Sight is an important part of how we understand the world and it only makes sense to make good use of this sense in our faith. The Christmas Season, which we just completed, reminds us that the Lord chose to take on a human body and thereby has consecrated our bodily reality—statuary reinforces this great truth.

Within this understanding of the body and its senses being an essential part of how we worship and serve God, the images of the saints provide us with a clear example and reminder of what kind of life we should lead in order to be pleasing to God ourselves. Bl. Michael McGivney, being an American saint, is one who can be very near and dear to each of us. The acts of his charity in providing assistance to widows and their children, for example, can encourage us to reach out to the vulnerable in our own midst. When we look upon a statue of Bl. Michael McGivney on our way into the church, the goal is that this will inspire us to respond to God's grace as he did and build upon the great work that Bl. Michael McGivney and countless others have done for the Kingdom of God.

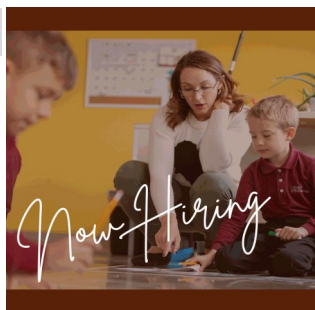
NOW HIRING — STFX SCHOOL JOB OPENING

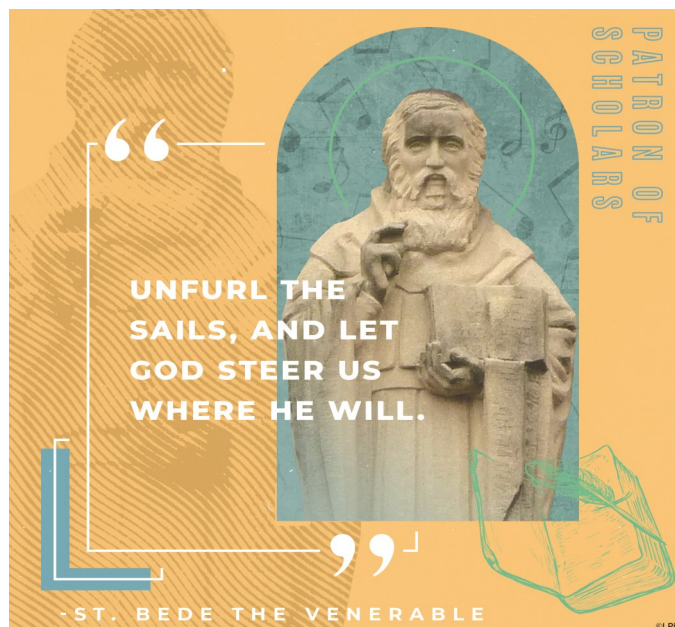

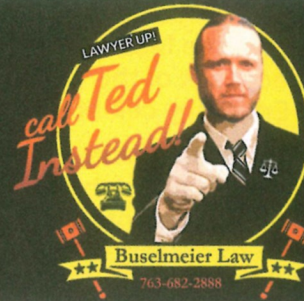

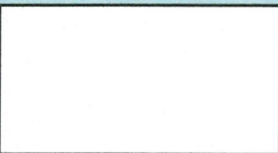
