FROM FATHER'S DESK

Father Nathaniel Meyers



It's hard to believe that we are now starting the final week of my time here at St. Francis Xavier. While technically my term does not end until June 30th, I will be taking the last two weeks of June as vacation time to both travel to Hartford for the diaconal ordination of Mitchell Kendrioski—who has been a wonderful teaching parish seminarian for the past three years and I'm sure will be a great homilist when he returns for his final year at St. Francis Xavier next fall—as well as to move over to Oakdale so that I can be mostly settled and ready to begin my work there on July 1st. After ten years in a parish, it's amazing to look back and think of all that has happened.

One thing I would like to encourage everyone here at St. Francis Xavier to remember as the parish transitions to a new priest is that while that transition will no doubt bring with it some challenges, it will also bring with it many blessings. Fr. Barnes will necessarily be different from me and this is neither good nor bad, because “different” is not a moral category. For many people, change is hard and it is tempting to view changes as bad, but they are inevitable. Perhaps some have forgotten that the first couple of years of my time in Buffalo were marked by changes and several people were upset and even angry at times over the changes, but the parish nevertheless weathered those changes and settled into them. As Fr. Barnes begins his tenure, my encouragement to everyone is not to try to prevent him changing things, but rather to assist him in changing things for the better.

Please note that making things “better” is not about getting what an individual or group wants, but rather about being more faithful to God and His Church. In God's Providence, Fr. Austin Barnes is being sent as the next shepherd of this parish and the parish will thrive only to the extent that its members cooperate with this reality. Whatever God wished to accomplish at St. Francis Xavier with me is now coming to an end, so the health of the parish will not be found in following me anymore. Instead, the future blessings and flourishing of St. Francis Xavier will be found by welcoming Fr. Barnes and embracing him as the servant leader of this wonderful parish and its school. Please pray for Fr. Barnes in the upcoming weeks and be ready to greet him with joyful hearts and an eagerness to follow his lead.




