I mentioned at Mass a couple of weekends ago that our Pork in the Parking Lot contest winner has chosen to make his prize of the reserved parking spot available to someone else when we return to the church after the construction project is completed on our parking lot. As a way of helping to raise some funds for little landscaping details that we can do around the parking lot, I have decided after consultation to do a raffle of the "BBQ Champion Reserved Parking" spot. Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS):

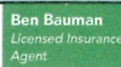

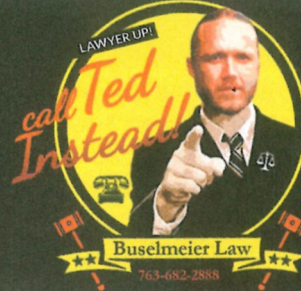
