

FROM FATHER'S DESK



Father Nathaniel Meyers

I mentioned at Mass a couple of weekends ago that our Pork in the Parking Lot contest winner has chosen to make his prize of the reserved parking spot available to someone else when we return to the church after the construction project is completed on our parking lot. As a way of helping to raise some funds for little landscaping details that we can do around the parking lot, I have decided after consultation to do a raffle of the "BBQ Champion Reserved Parking" spot. For a \$5.00 entry per "ticket" (with no limits on how many entries a person would be able to make), people can purchase a chance to win the reserved parking for a whole year. If you want to buy just one chance to win, then simply put in \$5; if you want to buy six chances to win, then simply put in \$30.

The process by which to enter is simple. Bring your money either to the parish office or place it in a sealed envelope in the weekend collection baskets, write your name and contact information on the provided piece of paper. In the office, we will create tickets with your names on it to be drawn at the conclusion of our 10:30 Mass on Sunday, August 27th. Then, whoever the lucky winner is can begin parking in that spot beginning September 1st and will keep that spot until August 31st of next year. Please be sure to get your entry to us by no later than close of our offices at 12:00 noon on Friday, August 25th.

<u>REMEMBER</u>: We have no place to store your peaches. If you are unable to pick them up, please find someone to pick them up for you.



Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS):

A Montessori based faith program for 3-6 year olds (Must be potty trained). Parents meet once/month and children come once/week.

Family of Faith (Grades 1st-5th): Parents and children meet twice/month at the Education Center and families have lessons at home the rest of the month.

Middle School Faith Formation (Grades 6th-8th): Students meet weekly at Education Center.

<u>Please Note:</u> Students preparing for Sacraments this year will have additional parent/child or teen meetings (schedule provided once signed up).

YDisciple - High School Youth: A group of 4-8 teens (with 1-2 adult trained leaders) meet weekly, all four years of High School. Recommended that teens create a group with friends, but not necessary. YD groups discuss their faith and how to live it out in their everyday lives.

We have all had moments when we seem to get a glimpse of Heaven. 
