

FROM FATHER'S DESK

Father Nathaniel Meyers



Next weekend will draw the Easter Season to a close with the great celebration of Pentecost. While this feast day is a marvelous one every year, it will be uniquely important this year as the Archdiocese will be concluding its Synod on Pentecost Sunday. Beginning Friday night, two members of our parish and I will be in attendance at the Synod throughout the weekend and deliberating with 500 other people on 40 propositions for the Archdiocese to form a strategic plan. I encourage everyone to devote time each day to pray for the success of the Synod, particularly asking the Holy Spirit to illumine the minds and hearts of all who are in attendance for it.

As the Synod will take place throughout the entire day on Saturday, I will not be able to celebrate Mass on Saturday evening next weekend. Fr. Dick Sudlik from the King's House will be coming to hear confessions and offer Mass at 5:00pm next weekend, so please join me in expressing gratitude for his generosity in ministering to our parish. The Pentecost Vigil Mass will be a longer one next weekend as there are extra readings for the Mass, much like at the Easter Vigil. Of course, the Mass will not be as long as the Easter Vigil, but it likely will have an additional 15 to 20 minutes due to the extra readings and prayers. I hope the Pentecost Vigil Mass will be a meaningful and powerful liturgy for all who are in attendance next weekend.

As the Easter Season draws to a close, we will each be responsible for carrying forth the hope and joy of the Resurrection to all we meet. In a world that seems to be tearing itself apart each day, the message of Christ's victory over sin and death is one that desperately needs to be not only told and heard, but most importantly lived. The Holy Spirit descended upon the Church at Pentecost so the Apostles could preach the Gospel to every nation; now, filled with that same Spirit, let us share the good news to every people.



UPCOMING FEAST DAY: ST. JOAN OF ARC

Patron Saint of Military Members Monday, May 30th

St. Joan of Arc (1412 – 1431) has had her story told throughout history through many books, movies and plays. She was born in the village of Domrémy, near the province of Lorraine, to a French peasant family. At a young age, she began to experience visions and voices, which were later identified to be of St. Michael, St. Catherine of



Alexandria, and St. Margaret of Antioch. At the age of 13, all three saints told her that she was to drive the English from French territory, and that she must bring the Dauphin to Reims for his coronation. Trusting in God, she did as she was told.

During the Hundred Years War, St. Joan of Arc led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiegne the following year, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft, eventually being found guilty and burned at the stake in Rouen. St. Joan of Arc was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 16, 1920.




