

FROM FATHER'S DESK

Father Nathaniel Meyers



Ordinarily, I take my retreat in the winter between the Christmas and Lent liturgical seasons, but my commitments in our Catholic school this year made it unfeasible to do so and, as a result, I am going to be making my retreat this upcoming week. After the Masses this weekend, I will venture over to my dad's house to bring my dogs to stay with him and also celebrate Father's Day, but following that I will be planning to make my way into seven days of silence where I will have a greater opportunity to pray, read, think, and appreciate stillness. Personally, I always enjoy making my canonical retreat each year, for it provides me with a much-needed time to recollect myself and begin afresh in pursuing God's work.

Silence is something that is mostly lost in our world today. Indeed, whenever silence intrudes upon our busy, noisy life we can even feel a certain sense of anxiety. I must confess that I do not make enough time for silence in my daily routines, often choosing to play a podcast in the background as I do house chores or whistling when I could choose to embrace quietness. Obviously whistling and podcasts are not inherently bad things, but they can be distractions that focus our minds away from God and what it is He wishes us to do with our lives. Silence can truly be a challenge—both in terms of actually obtaining it as well as wrestling with our own souls once we are in the silence—, but it is one of the surest ways for us to hear God's voice.

As I enter into my retreat this week, it will take me likely a full day to truly start to find silence as the noise of this world has quite the shelf life. However, each time I do get into the silence of my retreat, I find a beauty in it and start to treasure it. By the time I leave my retreat, I even miss the silence that I was able to maintain, however briefly. As I make my retreat this week, be assured of my prayers for all of you and please pray for me that it will be a worthy and fruitful time of silence.
